

Special Cutting Notes

1. Prewash your fabric as your material may shrink after the first wash.
2. After pre-washing your fabric, fold the fabric in half lengthwise with the wrong sides together. Then press, making sure there is a crisp fold line on the material.
3. Circle the correct layout diagram based on size and style. The sample Kuspuk pattern layouts for all the sizes are included in this online course. All the pattern pieces for all the sizes will be laid out on a 45 inch width of fabric. There are only 2 styles to choose from in the Kuspuk patterns (the kuspuk with the skirt and the kuspuk without the skirt). If making a kuspuk without the skirt, do not layout and cut out the flounce pattern pieces.
4. Layout the pattern pieces on the right side of fabric (refer to the sample pattern layout diagram). Lay all the pattern pieces on the fabric before pinning any of them in place. This will allow you to make sure all the pieces will fit on the fabric. Then cut out your fabric pieces.
5. Check to make sure you have all the fabric pieces.

Back - cut 1

Front - cut 2

Sleeve - cut 2

Cuff - cut 2

Pocket - cut 2

Hood - cut 4

Flounce - cut 2
